How Does U.S. Diplomacy Benefit Americans?

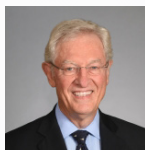
**Thursday, October 14, 2021

This webinar is open to the public, but places are limited.

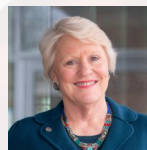

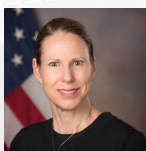
